SECOND ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists (the "Board") is in receipt of a request from Shane Perrault, License No. 4005, asking for modification of the terms of the Consent Order, dated May 11, 2012. Based on extenuating personal and financial circumstances, Dr. Perrault requests an extension of time in order to make a charitable contribution of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) to an organization that provides mental health services. Upon consideration of Dr. Perrault's request, and noting that Dr. Perrault has been compliant with the education and supervision requirements of the Order, the Board voted to modify the terms of its Consent Order as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this 11th day of October, 2013, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists, hereby,

ORDERED that Dr. Perrault make a charitable contribution in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), through anonymous payment or documented in-kind services, to a non-profit organization that provides mental health services, no later than May 12, 2015; and be it further,

ORDERED that all of the other terms of the May 11, 2012, Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a modification to a formal order of the Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
